Brooklyn Connections – Proposed Traffic Resolution

Brooklyn Connections aims to improve safety, accessibility and connectivity along the Brooklyn Road and Ohiro Road corridor. The project includes a range of changes to the road layouts, pedestrian facilities, public transport infrastructure and cycling connections.

In late June, Wellington City Council adopted the 2026-2027 Annual Plan which included the decision to proceed and consult with the community again about the Brooklyn Connections project. We would now like to get your feedback on the revised proposed changes.

This document outlines what is being proposed and how you can have your say. We encourage you to read the information below alongside the information on the website to understand the proposed changes and how they may affect your neighbourhood.

Consultation is open from Monday 13 July to Monday 3 August 2026.

Reference	TR67-26 Brooklyn to City Improvements - Cycleway
Location – where we propose to make the change	We are proposing to make changes along Brooklyn Road and Ohiro Road (between Willis Street and Cleveland Street)
What we'd like to do	We propose to construct bike and bus infrastructure along Brooklyn Road and Ohiro Road to the intersection of Ohiro Road/Cleveland Street. This project will result in changes to the way some areas of road and footpaths are currently used including: • Removal of on-street parking • Removal and relocation of bus stops • New pedestrian zebra crossing at existing median refuge crossing outside property #143B Ohiro Road. Proposed summary of changes: • Slight shift (shortening the bus stop box) at the bus stop (ID 6716), west of Washington Avenue/Brooklyn Road intersection • Removal of bus stop (ID:6719) outside property #185 Ohiro Road • Relocation of bus stop (ID:6718) from outside property #159A, Ohiro Road to outside property #171 Ohiro Road) • Slight shift (shortening the bus stop box) at bus stop (ID 7718), opposite to Bretby Crescent • Removal of roadside parking along Ohiro Road Southbound Lane 4 parking spaces (outside property #169, 171 and #175)

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	• Removal of roadside parking along Ohiro Road northbound lane 20 parking spaces (south of property #184 access and north of property #158 access) • Removal of roadside parking along Ohiro Road northbound lane 5 parking spaces (north of the Tanera Crescent/Ohiro Road intersection) • Removal of roadside parking along Brooklyn Road northbound lane 8 parking spaces (east of Ohiro Road/Brooklyn Road intersection) • Installation of a flush pedestrian (zebra) crossing on Ohiro Road outside property #143 • Proposed cycle lane in southbound direction along Brooklyn Road from Nairn Street/Willis Street intersection to outside property #159A, Ohiro Road • Proposed cycle lane in northbound direction from approx. 25m north from Cleveland Road/Ohiro Road intersection to opposite property #145, Ohiro Road • Changes to 15 roadside parallel parking spaces to 33 90-degree angled parking spaces along Helen Street southern kerbline.
Why we are proposing the change	In 2021, Wellington City Council trialled a temporary uphill bike and scooter lane on Brooklyn Road through Waka Kotahi NZTA's Innovating Streets programme. The trial was designed to test safer street layouts and gather community feedback before considering permanent changes. Following public consultation in June and July 2023, Councillors approved a package of permanent walking, biking and bus improvements for the corridor. Since then, the funding environment has changed significantly. The project has lost NZTA co-funding and funding available for Wellington's bike network programme was reduced. In response, we reviewed the design and looked for ways to retain the most important safety and accessibility improvements while reducing costs. Because the proposal and scope has changed, we are engaging with the community for feedback before any further decisions are made.
Impact	Net parking impact: ○ Permanent removal of 29 roadside unrestricted parking spaces along Ohiro Road ○ Permanent removal of 8 roadside unrestricted parking spaces along Brooklyn Road northbound ○ Permanent removal of 15 roadside parallel unrestricted parking spaces on Helen Street ○ Addition of 33 90-degree angled unrestricted parking spaces on Helen Street.

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	Overall, the changes result in a net gain of 18 parking spaces on Helen Street and a net loss of 37 parking spaces along Ohiro Road and Brooklyn Road. The Brooklyn Connections project will improve safety and accessibility for people who choose to walk along a key transport corridor and an important route in Wellington's bike network. The proposed changes are designed to make it safer and easier for people travelling through the area by bike, scooter, on foot, and by bus. New and upgraded pedestrian crossing facilities will improve access to bus stops, footpaths and cycle lanes, making it easier and safer for people to move through the area. Changes to bus stop locations and layouts will also help improve the efficiency of bus services. By improving walking, cycling and public transport connections, the project supports safer, more accessible and lower-carbon travel choices for residents, commuters, students and visitors travelling through Brooklyn.
Other options considered	Option 1: - Raised pedestrian zebra crossing along Brooklyn Road and Ohiro Road at existing pedestrian crossing. This option is not preferred as Brooklyn Road is a heavy vehicles route for vehicles going to the landfill sites. Option 2: - Various angles (45-degree, 60 degree) for Helen Street parking arrangements. The most efficient way of increasing the parking numbers on Helen Street is to install 90-degree parking.
How this relates to the parking policy	- Support shift in type of transport used – facilitate a shift to using active (eg walking and cycling) and public transport through parking management and pricing, to move more people driving fewer vehicles. - Support safe movement – facilitate the safe and efficient movement of people and goods by focusing on people moving along transport corridors rather than people parking or storing stationary vehicles. - Support move to becoming an eco-city – facilitate the uptake of car sharing, electric vehicles and other transport with low carbon emissions. Manage parking and incentivise a decrease in vehicle use to contribute to reduced carbon emissions, better water quality, air quality, stormwater management and biodiversity outcomes.

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Additional Information	The project objective of this investment is that by the completion date, Wellington City Council delivers good quality and safe multi-modal transport infrastructure for all road users on this route to Brooklyn. The work is fully aligned with the bike network plan and other Council objectives. The Bus Priority Action Plan identified there are 3500 bus passengers on this route daily • Average daily cycle count – 164 • Average daily traffic count – on Ohiro Road (between Tanera Crescent and Todman Street), the 7-day average daily traffic count in both directions is 12,695 vehicles per day. • 41 crashes have been recorded in the NZTA Crash Analysis database over the last five years along the Brooklyn Road and Ohiro Road section, including 20 were injury crashes.

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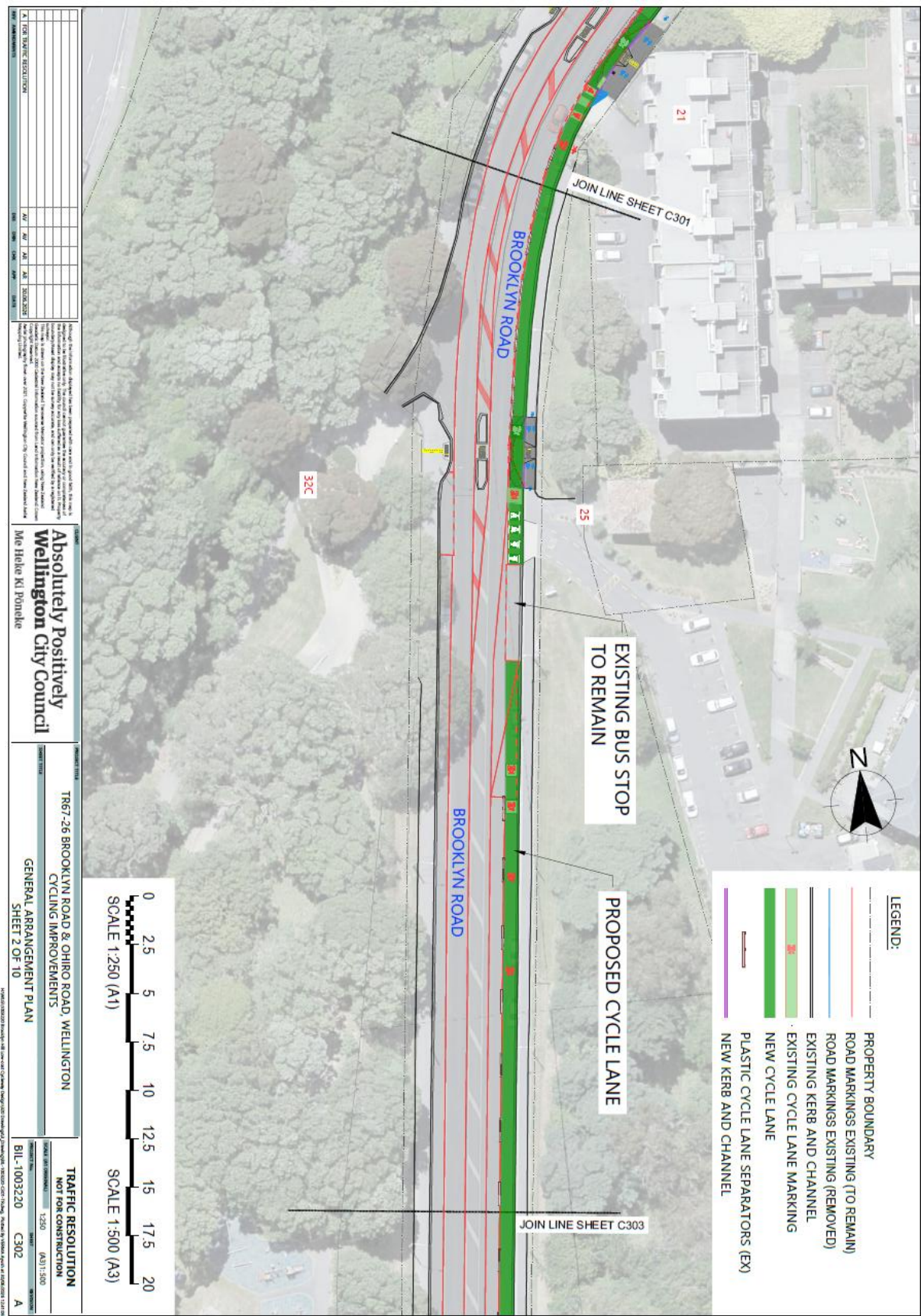
Traffic Resolution Plan 1: TR67-26 Brooklyn to City Improvements - Cycleway



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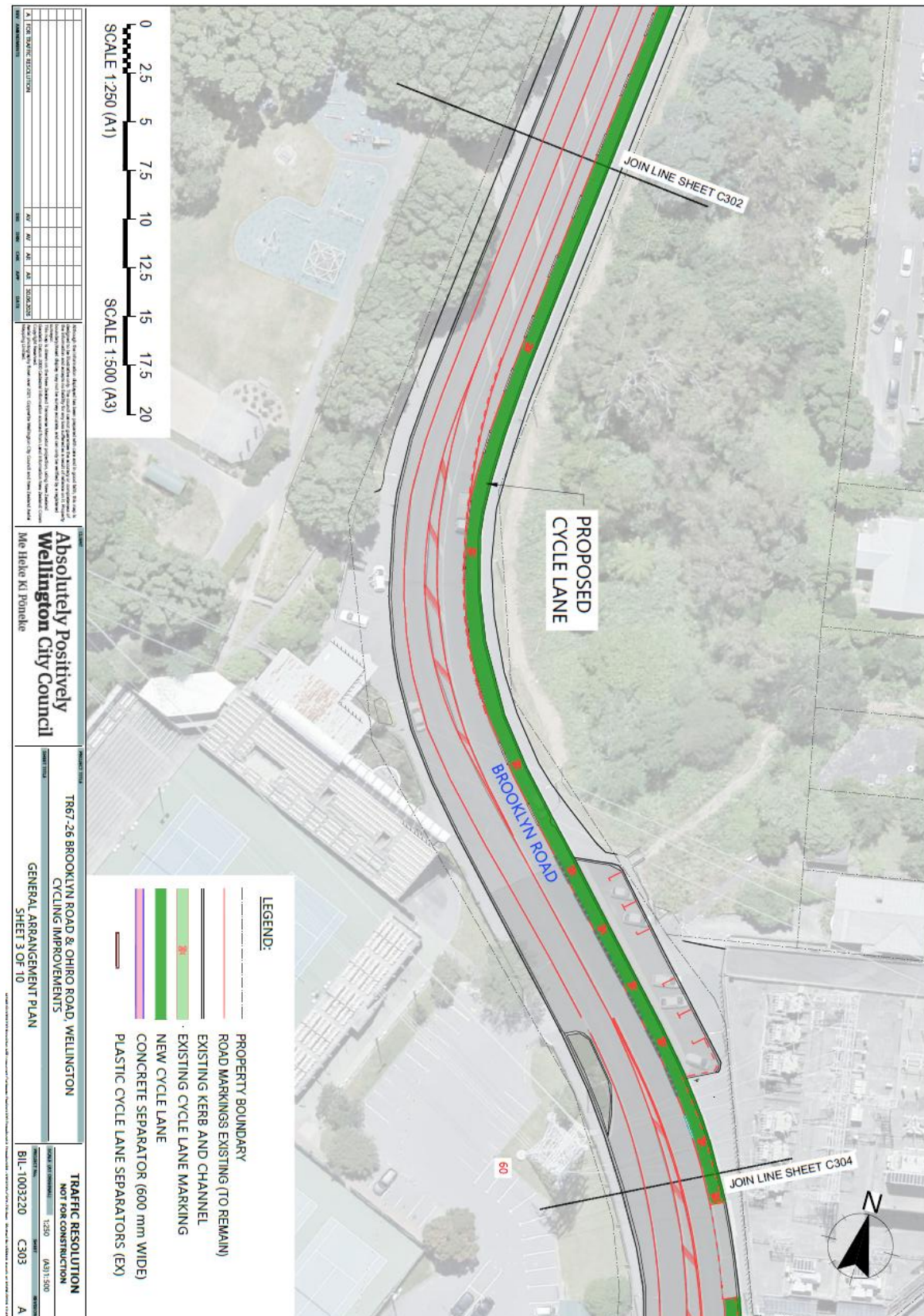
Traffic Resolution Plan 2: TR67-26 Brooklyn to City Improvements - Cycleway



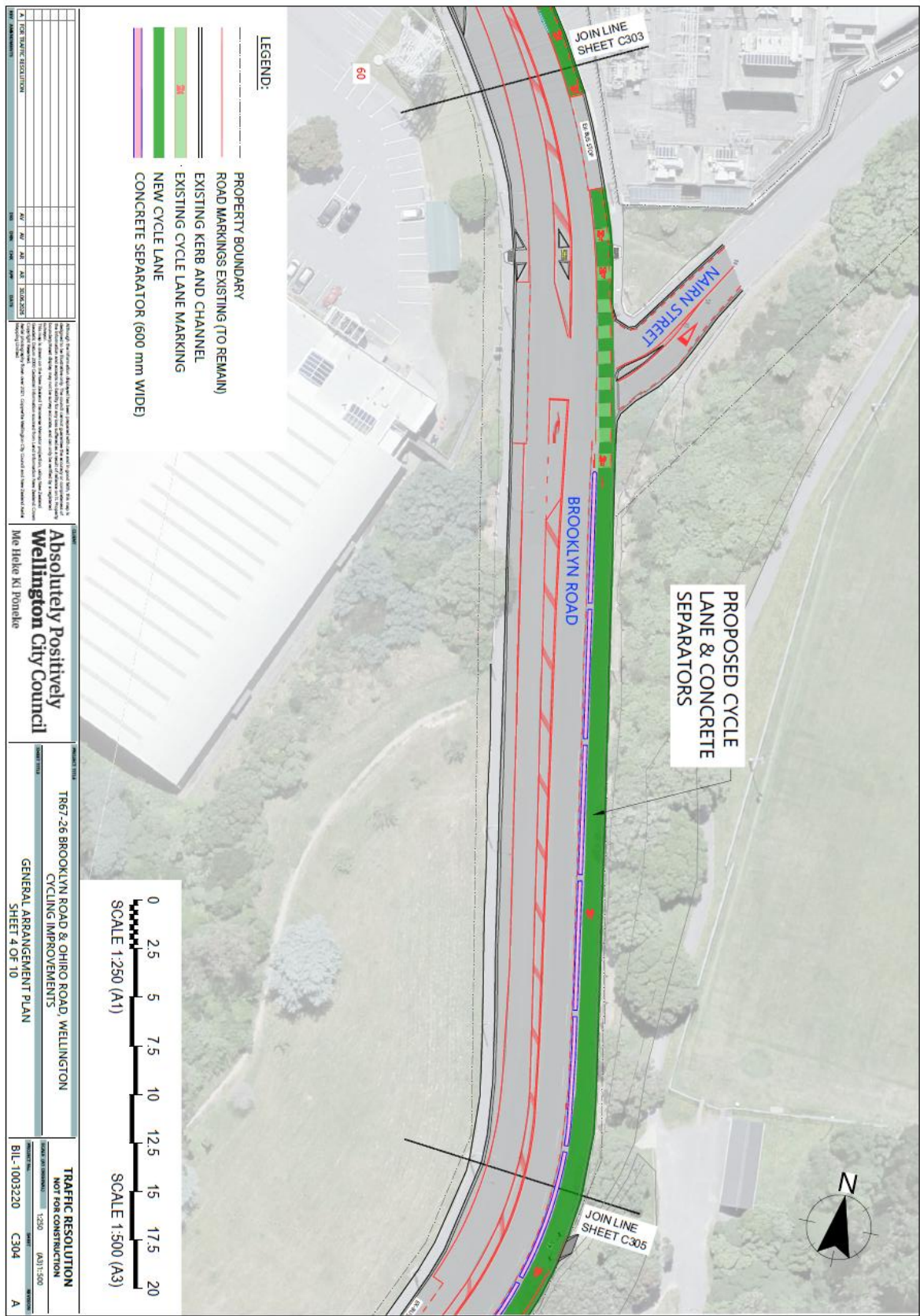
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Traffic Resolution Plan 3: TR67-26 Brooklyn to City Improvements - Cycleway



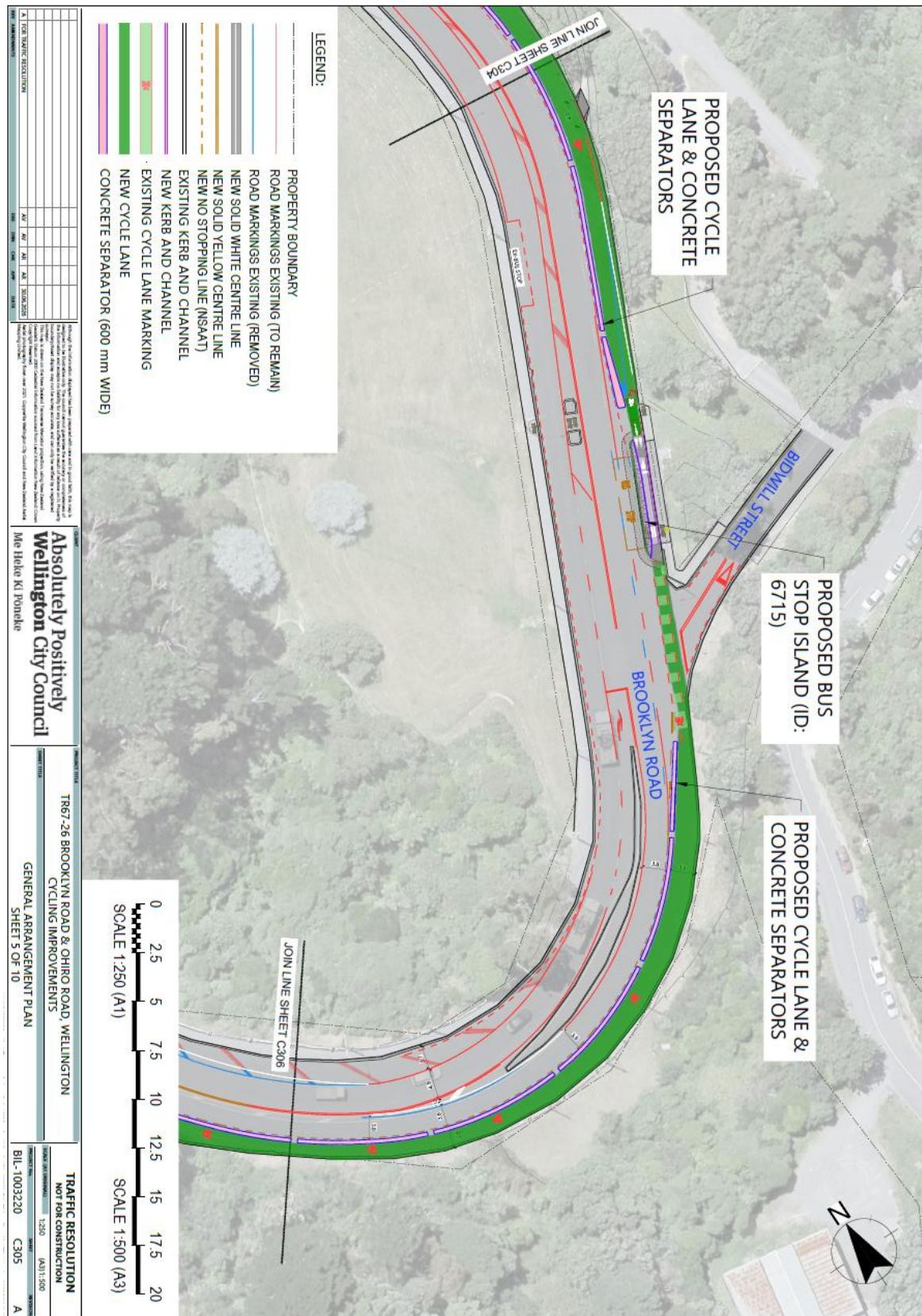

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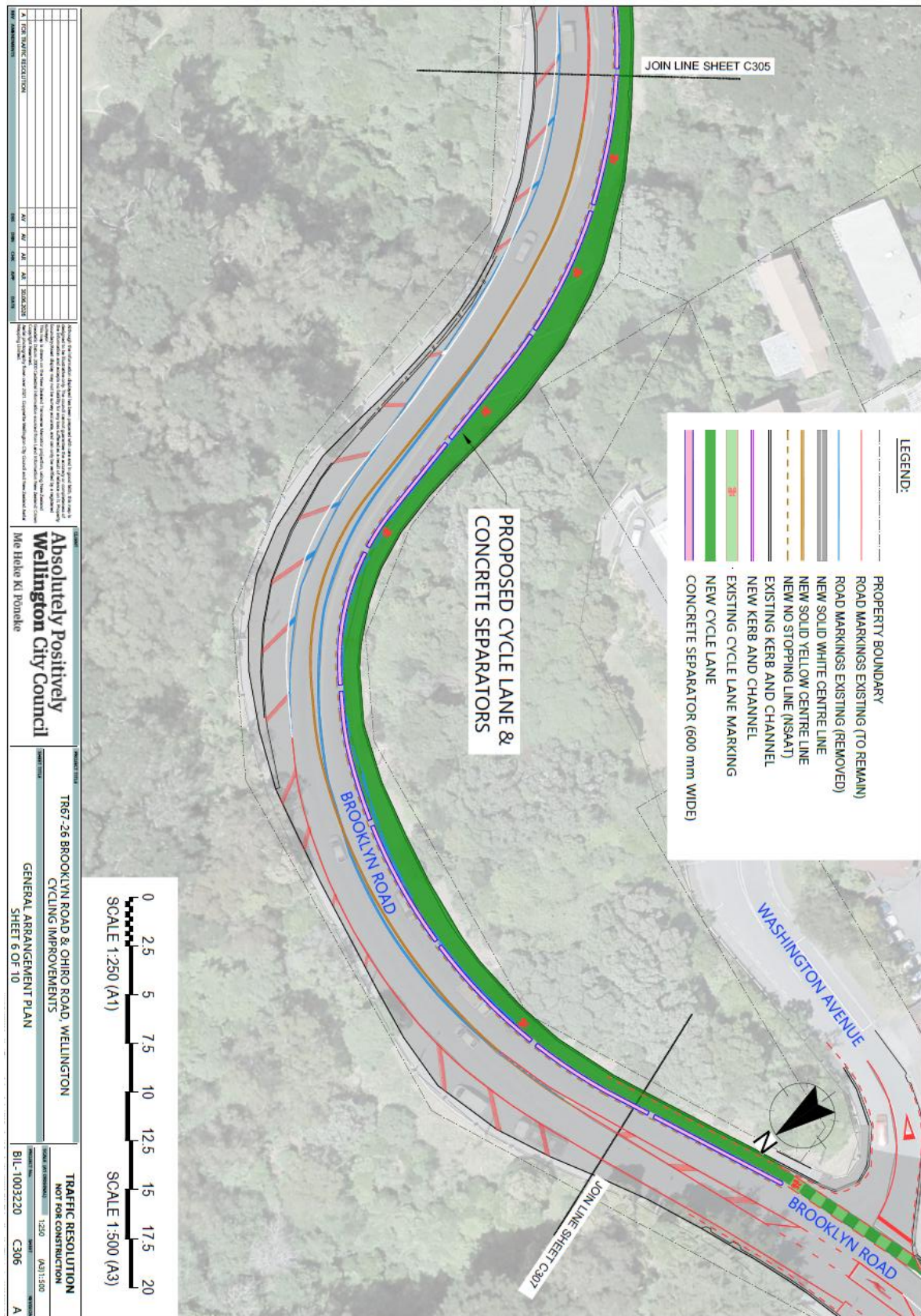

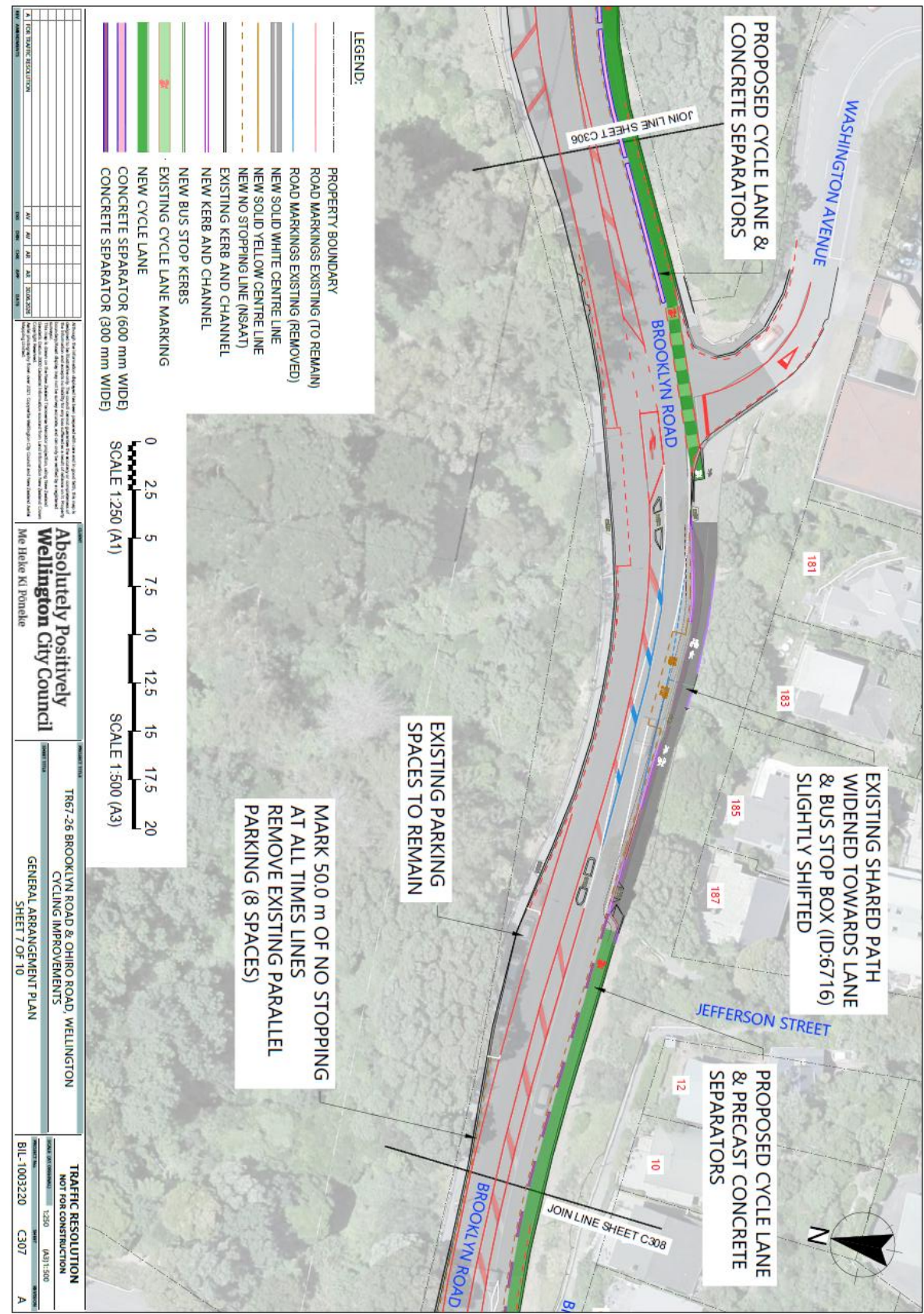
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Traffic Resolution Plan 6: TR67-26 Brooklyn to City Improvements - Cycleway



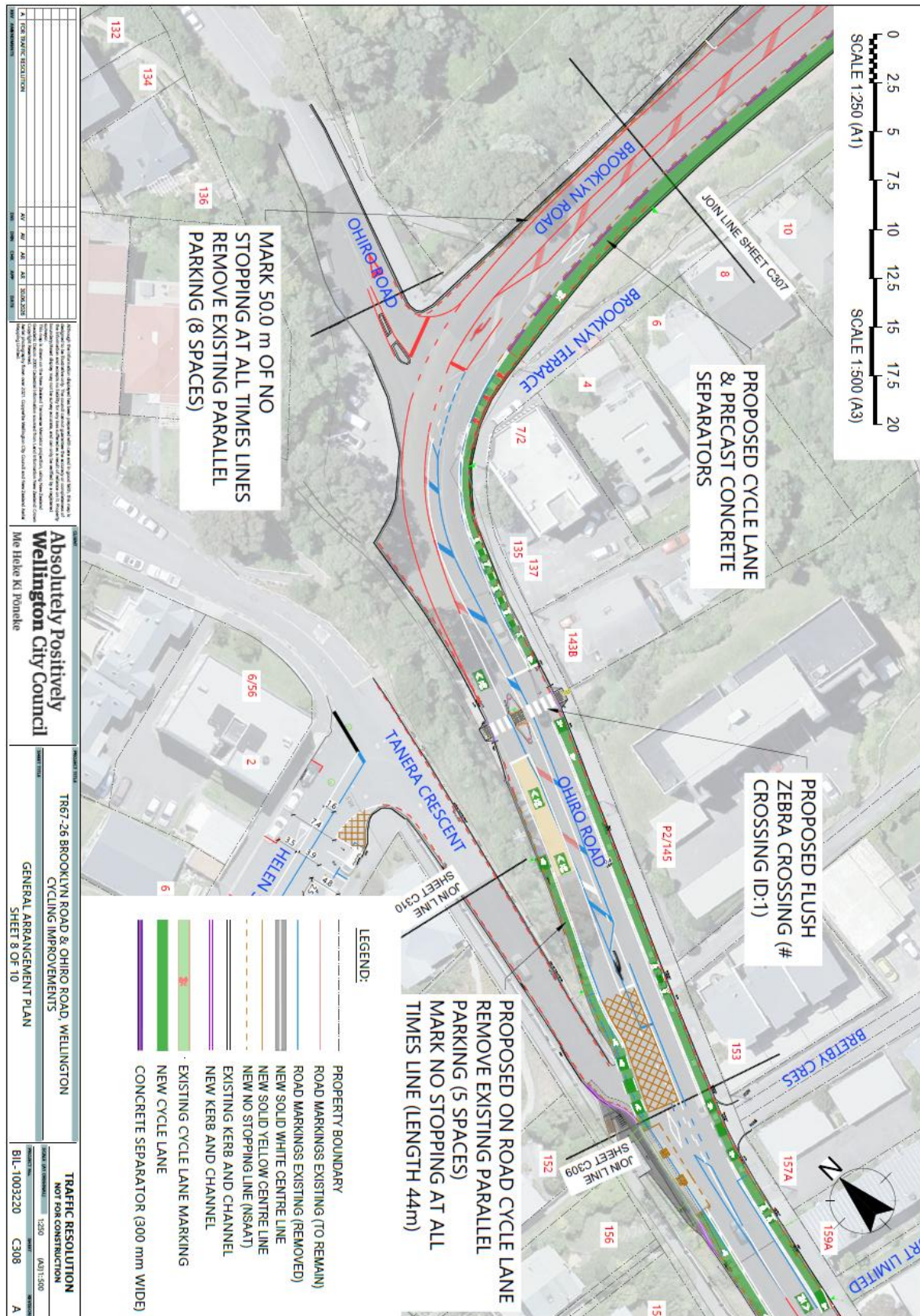
